ban on sugary drinks in schools

Step 2 Identify the Question The underlying question is Should sugary drinks be banned in schools

Step 3 Analyze the Information The information presented is that sugary drinks contribute to childhood obesity This requires further evidence statistics on obesity rates correlation between sugary drink consumption and obesity etc

Step 4 Evaluate Inferences The inference is that banning sugary drinks will reduce childhood obesity This is a causal inference that needs further justification eg evidence that bans have been effective elsewhere

Step 5 Examine Concepts Key concepts include sugary drinks childhood obesity and ban These need clear definitions to avoid ambiguity

Step 6 Identify Assumptions The assumption is that reducing sugary drink consumption directly correlates to reducing obesity Other factors influencing obesity eg lack of exercise genetics are not considered

Step 7 Explore Implications Implications include potential economic consequences for school vendors student reactions and the effectiveness of the ban itself

Step 8 Consider Point of View The argument is presented from a public health perspective Other viewpoints such as those of school vendors or students could offer different perspectives
